Minutes of Meeting held on 13th May 2008, Shaw Social Club

1. Mark Fordham welcomed everybody to the meeting, which commenced at 8.05 pm.

3. Presentation Night 14th June 2008

Pam Haines confirmed that there is £1100 in the account at present, and that approximately £500 will need to be spent on trophies. Cost will be £5 per person and all Captains are reminded that they should provide a raffle prize.

4. Return of Trophies

5. Trophies for Presentation Night

David Goddard will be checking with R&D Trophies concerning supply and cost for engraving of non-returnable trophies that will be given to all winning players to keep. Mark Fordham also confirmed that a colleague who works at Timpsons will be doing the engraving on the main “perpetual” trophies. Mark will also discuss the possibility of Timpsons providing the non-returnable trophies and subsequent engraving.

It was also felt that new trophies may be required in the future, but for this season the existing trophies will be used.

6. A.G.M.

This is confirmed as 8th July 2008, and main concern will be election of a new chairperson for the league. Tony Denney of Black Horse stated that if nobody puts his or her name forward, he would be willing to stand.

7. A.O.B.

There was some discussion of new teams for the league. Mark Fordham confirmed that the Conservative Club are a definite, and that Rising Sun at Stockcross and the Lamb Inn at Curridge had been sent details on the league but have not yet responded. These will be contacted shortly for confirmation. It was also mentioned that The Gun and British Legion may also be interested, and Mark Fordham confirmed that he would send details.
